ONLINE COURSES: Courses taught completely online. First Term instructors will give students instructions **via Mars Hill email account** sometime between Friday, August 11 and Sunday, August 13; Full Term sometime between Friday, August 18 and Sunday, August 20; and for Second Term sometime between Friday, October 13 and Sunday, October 15. **Students MUST sign into Moodle before Friday, August 18 (First Term) or before Monday, August 28 (Full Term) and by Friday, October 20 (Second Term) or be dropped from the course.** Necessary computing requirements: (1) High speed internet connection (DSL, Cable Modem), (2) Windows 7/XP/Vista, MacOS, inux, and (3) Firefox or Internet Explorer.
