

APPENDIX I: Suggested Four-Year Schedules

Music and Education Courses

The schedules on the following pages reflect guidelines and restrictions that are identified in the *College Catalog*. Important issues include prerequisites, sequencing, status requirements, and the semesters during which the courses are typically offered. For example,

- During the Fall semester, **all Freshmen** entering as music and musical theatre majors enroll *concurrently* in MUS 111 (Theory I), MUS 113 (Aural Skills I), and MUS 177 (Class Piano).
- Upon successful completion of the above *sequence* of courses, the student enrolls *concurrently* in MUS 112 (Theory II), MUS 114 (Aural Skills II), and MUS 273 (Professional Keyboard Skills) for the Spring semester.
- MTH 107 (Finite Math) is a *prerequisite* for MUS 217 (Music Theory/Tech IV).
- Singer-on-Stage I-IV must be taken in *sequence*.
- Performance majors must achieve *Junior or Senior status* before enrolling in MLIT (Literature of the Applied Instrument) or MPED (Pedagogy of the Applied Instrument).

In order to avoid problems and meet requirements, Music and Education courses are to be completed in the order indicated on the schedules.

Foundation & Perspectives General Education Courses

All full-time students must take an English course every semester until the English 111-112 is complete. Perspectives courses (e.g., Humanities) provide students with choice and flexibility; they can be taken out of sequence or during summer school sessions. The suggested schedules provide examples of achieving balance among the number and types of courses. Always check for prerequisites.

Developmental Courses

The following courses are determined by placement tests administered at the beginning of a student's first semester. If any of the courses are required, the student must complete them before continuing in the general education or major programs, as indicated below.

- ED 101 (College Reading) and ENG 101 (Basic Writing) must be completed before ENG 111.
- MTH 101 (Basic Mathematics) must be completed before MTH 107.
