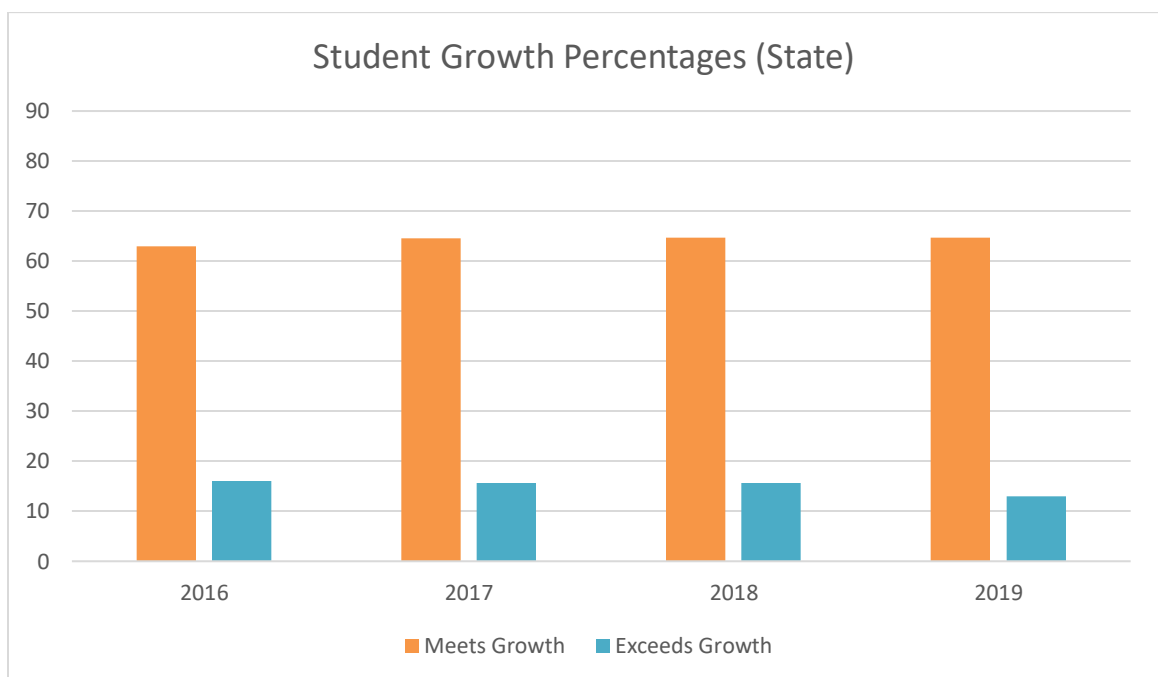
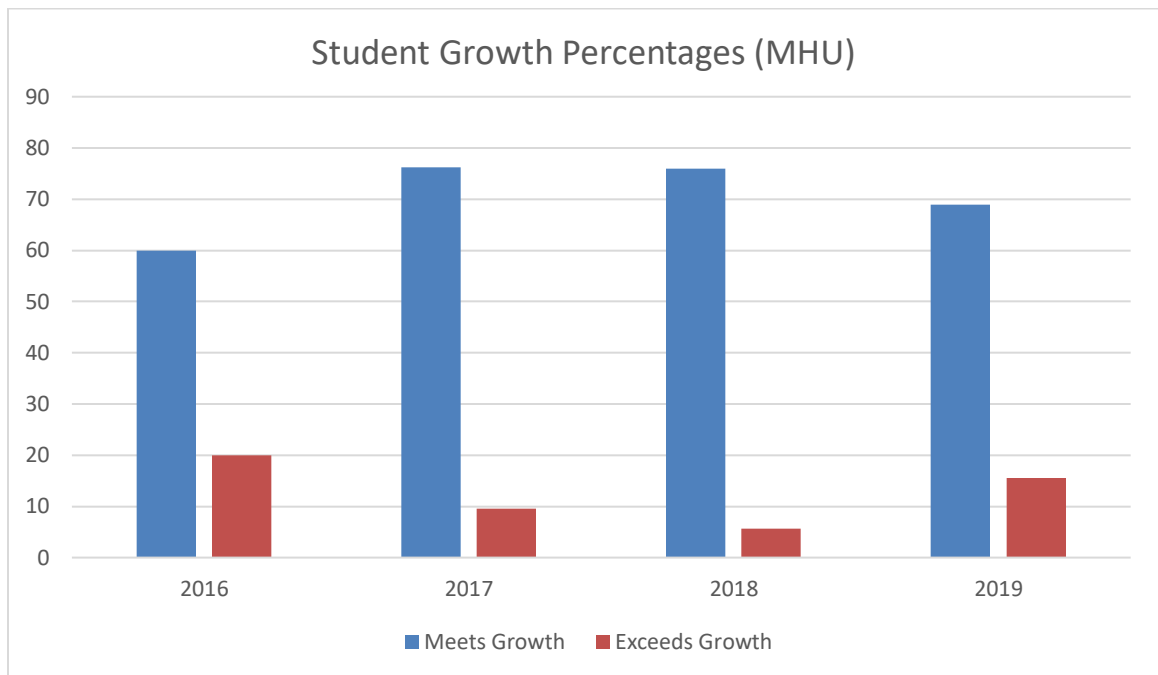


## Teacher Value Added performance levels and candidate performance measures

Since the 2015-2016 academic year, North Carolina has reported value-added measures for recent graduates of state Educator Preparation Programs. These data indicate the percentage of Mars Hill University education graduates whose P-12 students meet or exceed growth expectations in a given year. Reports are delayed a year (e.g., 2016 was reported in 2017; 2017 data was reported in 2018). Additionally, the state provides the same data for comparison in the state. Below are the comparative MHU and state data for 2016, 2017, 2018, and 2019:
