Graduation Rate

Mars Hill University tracks graduation rates for the institution but does not disaggregate by major or program. As a result, the EPP used internal data collected on students admitted to the teacher education program and students completing the education program. Graduation rate for initial licensure education programs was calculated by determining the average number of semesters from admission to completion of the program (4 semesters). We took 150% of that number (6 semesters) in order to capture the most students and mirror the 6-year graduation rate calculated by Mars Hill University. 7 semesters of graduation rate data are provided below.

The other student transferred to another institution after being counseled out of the program.
